Bug Fixes and Enhancements

General

1. Configuration changes to address Internet Explorer 11 browser compatibility issues (746) and Google Chrome and Safari time-out errors (714)

1. Fixed issue where jobs without a fitness level did not appear in the Reference Data/Jobs screen (743)

1. Fixed problem with Master Record report where equivalent courses were being repeated if more than one person was selected for the report (758)

ROSS Management

- 1. Fixed issue where "Resolve" button on Unresolved Results tab was not functioning (767)
- 2. Fixed issue where IQS was not correctly trapping for invalid ROSS username or password resulting in user's easily making 3 incorrect tries and locking their account 781)

Training Course Schedule

1. Fixed issue where if the user entered a new scheduled course with the same course, location, start date and end dates as a previously entered course an exception error was generated. Now the user gets a pop-up message stating the course already exists.

Transfer In/Out

1. When transferring files in from either IQS or IQCS, a message was added that if the file cannot be read by IQS the user needs to contact the agency who created the file to have them provide a file in the correct format.
